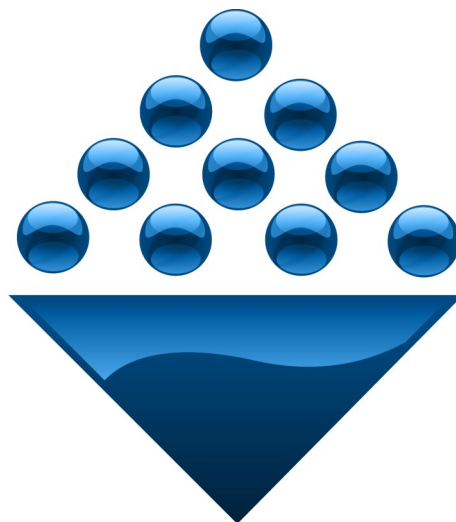

Solids Handling and Processing Industry Awards 2015

Awards Criteria

Export Award. To be awarded to the organisation which has achieved a step change in their export activities, either by a percentage increase in exports or success in opening up new market(s). Award criteria:-

- Achievement(s) relative to the size of the organisation
- Increased export sales across several markets or in one market, demonstrated by relevant sales figures (confidentiality will be respected).
- A simple narrative explaining how this has been achieved
- Consideration will be given to new, imaginative or bold actions or specific activities that have resulted in export achievements.

The Innovation Award. To be awarded to the organisation/collaborating organisations responsible for introducing a new product or service, or substantial modification to an existing product or service. Award criteria:-

- Achievement(s) relative to the size of the organisation
- Innovation or innovative thinking, eg in design or application

Shapa Company of the Year. To be awarded on the basis of achievements, either through sales success or best practice. Award criteria:-

- Achievement(s) relative to the size of the organisation
- Increased sales
- Recognition for best practice

Shapa Individual Award. To be awarded to an individual who has contributed significantly to the Bulk Solids Handling and Processing Industry. Award criteria:-

- Contribution(s) in areas such as sales, new markets, design, environmental or innovation that has/have greatly benefited their company or organisation.
- A simple narrative explaining how this has been achieved

Shapa Customer of the year. To be awarded to a manufacturer/processor on the basis of achievements in the handling or processing of bulk solids. Award criteria:-

- Achievement(s) relative to the size of the organisation.
- Cost savings, quality, productivity or environmental improvements arising from investments in people, plant and/or machinery.
- Consideration will be given to applications where there is evidence that new, imaginative or bold ideas have been embraced as part of a new solids handling or processing project.

Solids Handling and Processing Industry Awards 2015

Awards Rules

1. Entry to these awards is open to all UK registered, member and non-member companies and institutions operating in the solids handling and processing industry. The industry comprises equipment manufacturers and systems suppliers directly involved in the handling and processing of particulate solids.

In respect of applications for the Shapa Individual Award, the organisation making the application must have the permission of both the candidate and the organisation that the candidate is linked to, is employed by or represents. Evidence to be provided as part of the application.

In respect of applications for the Shapa Customer of the Year Award, eligibility shall be extended to include users and processors directly involved in the handling and processing of particulate solids.

2. Winners will be announced and presented at the awards ceremony to be held in the evening directly after the SHAPA AGM on Tuesday 12th April 2016
3. Shortlisted applicants are expected to attend the awards ceremony
4. All categories are awarded based on the decision of our independent panel of judges.
5. An organisation may enter multiple categories.
6. The deadline for applications will be the 28th February 2016
7. The shortlisted entrants will be notified in the third week of March
8. The judges' decision is final, no correspondence will be entered into and no reasons given for decisions.
9. All information provided to the judges will be used solely for the purposes of assessing the entries. Potentially sensitive information will not be made public.
10. The winners of the award are able to use the award in any publicity providing that they quote the relevant year of attainment.
11. Shapa will publicise the award and its winners on its web site and in relevant journals
